Date: Friday, October 3rd, 2025

Director: (Nic):

- First week of rehearsals complete! Will begin blocking the show starting Monday.
 - Platforming would be more important to complete for blocking purposes compared to all other scenic pieces
 - *Sunday In The Park With George* Viewing Party Tonight – Everyone is invited 😊
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Music Director (Katie):

- Will continue to scale back track levels as actors get comfortable musically and learn blocking.
 - Would like to find a time for Dave to visit rehearsal to hear the tracks in the space.
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Scenery (Nate & Dylan):

- Will be utilizing Fred furniture for blocking rehearsals.
 - There will be no case for the piano – just additional, smaller masking.
 - Budget & Build Timeline is posted in the google drive and includes an itemized task list.
 - Is currently on schedule and within budget.
 - Base floor to be completed on Wednesday – Stage Management will be placing dots near the clock numbers on the INSIDE of the clock.
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Costumes (Anna, Logan, Apollo):

- In good shape - Has begun ordering pieces and are discussing what must be built V.S bought.
 - All 3 actors have gone for measurements
 - Shoe-wise, Ellie will be wearing short heels (likely wedge) and will be discussing with the actor what she is more comfortable in.
 - Shoe-wise, Gavin will be wearing loafers due to profession and character, while Sean will be wearing something comfortable and casual.
 - Can pull pieces into rehearsals for actors to utilize.
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Props (Mandy, Apollo):

- Will continue to update props list throughout the process.
 - For Therapy, 2 landline phones that Dr. Nic would like the cords to be flexible in moving anywhere on the Fred Stage, including the platforms. – may need to splice together to get the longest length possible between the receiver and the phone.
 - One to be connected to an apartment unit, living upstage so that it is not visible at all times.
 - One to be held offstage in a Vom by a crew member (or potentially attached to a piece of wood).
 - Thinking 44ft (or as far as possible)
 - Would like to have a steering wheel prop for the car scene.
 - Script mentions Jon having a joint – Dr.Nic is completely okay with this idea, and it does not necessarily need to smoke and rather be a prop that is simply held.
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Lights (Mandy, Coleman):

- Hoping to have backlight on the floor behind the windows and this should be okay for blocking purposes – may just need to find different spaces to hang clothes.
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Sound (Dave, Alex):

- Will not be moving to a center cluster speaker – loved the sound of the tracks in the space as it is.
 - No reverb issues during rehearsals this week.
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Dramaturgy (Ozzy):

- Main workload in the upcoming weeks will be answering rehearsal questions and uploading information to the in-progress dramaturgy website
 - All dramaturgy content is currently embedded on our digital callboard!
