Scenery (Nate & Dylan):

- There will be 2 brick wall-textured flats upstage of the clock on the floor angled facing inwards, with black fire escape ladders that can be used as a location for lighting fixtures, rather than for actor-use.
 - Windows will be designed as a frosted glass panel there will be 2 windows on one brick wall and 1 window on the other, which you cannot see through.
 - The top of the walls will be breaking away
 - o Posters will be located across the brick walls
 - If posters do not work on the 2 brick walls, they could be located along the hallway entering the Fred, where the glass lobby displays are. This could also include time period news reports.
- Cityscape with piano keys design (as found on our show poster) to be placed behind the seating on all 3 sides of the Fred will need to determine the best way to be rigged (potentially from the grid).
 - o Two separate panels The cityscape and the solid black piano keys to create depth.
- Gray-concrete texture on the floors with a counterclockwise shifted clock (12 being where 10 stands) and painted to fade in/out with the space (not distinct/clean, but blurry on the edges)
 - o The clock does not need to include the hands and could be created through lighting.
- Drawers for furniture to hide items, but can also sit on top, move around stage.
- Table & 2 Chairs, along with piano (which will need to include a battery pack from Dave)
- Will have to extend the apron of the stage and add steps
- Black traveler upstage closed & masking to be added Actors can still enter from upstage center.
- Build Schedule as of right now to start first week of rehearsal Starting with the stage extension, followed by the walls/windows/furniture.
 - o Under budget & hope to complete by the 3rd week of rehearsal

Costumes (Anna, Logan, Apollo):

- Jon, Michael, and Susan will all have statement piece watch's, while playing respective characters to fit with the theme of time.
- Many pieces that indicate a change in character will be quick to throw on and may require less rigging than initially expected
- Jon: Early-mid 8os fashion, variety of colors.
- Susan: Costumes to emphasize in movement, settled (grounded), muted color palette, stiffer fabrics.
 - Judy: Clean cut jacket, typical business-wear.
 - o Karessa: Less grounded than surrounding characters, floral pattern.
- Michael: Wall-street, put together look. Base outfit is collared shirt and slacks to add over.
 - O Dad: Scary looking, imposing that induces Jon's anxiety (Opposite for Mom)
 - o Counter guy: Big, bulky letterman-jacket.
- Rosa: Snake-skin pattern, distinctive, standing out against surrounding characters.
- 1+2: Time-period outerwear, JC Penny hats
- Colored final design & renderings to be completed by first rehearsal & uploaded to Google Drive folder.

Props (Mandy):

• Will be creating props list with Apollo and can be found in the Google Drive.

Lights (Mandy, Coleman):

- Lighting breakdown is in progress and can be found in the Google Drive
- Will be meeting with Dr. Nic to discuss overall feelings for each song
- Currently looking at utilizing 2 movers.

Sound (Dave, Alex):

- The metronome located on stage will be amplified and the cast will have to start, stop, and wind.
- Is working on a QLAB file with the performance tracks that can be used during rehearsal
